Vision

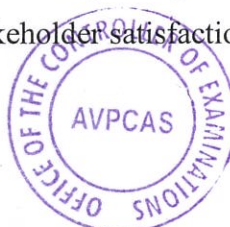
To establish a credible, transparent, technology-enabled, and learner-centric examination system that ensures academic integrity, fairness, accuracy, and excellence in assessment and certification.

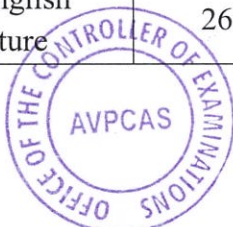

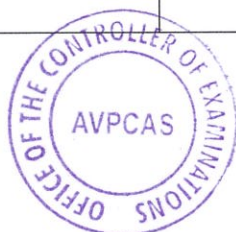
